Treating benign germ cell tumors. Women with benign (non-cancerous) germ cell tumors such as mature teratomas (dermoid cysts) are cured by removing the part of the ovary that has the tumor (ovarian cystectomy) or by removing the entire ovary.

Ovarian cancer is hard to detect early. Women with ovarian cancer may have no symptoms or mild symptoms until the disease is in an advanced stage.

Cancer is a group of diseases involving abnormal cell growth with the potential to invade or spread to other parts of the body. These contrast with benign tumors, which do not spread. Possible signs and symptoms include a lump, abnormal bleeding, prolonged cough, unexplained weight loss and a change in bowel movements. While these symptoms may indicate cancer, they can also have other causes.

An oophorectomy is a surgical procedure to remove one or both of the ovaries. A bilateral oophorectomy, removal of both ovaries, will result in infertility and premature menopause for women who are still menstruating. A unilateral oophorectomy, removal of one ovary, may be possible for some young women with certain types of early-stage ovarian cancer.
