Fourth Suit Forcing Your Bridge

Fourth Suit Forcing. Mr. Norman Squire, 1907-1991, of England introduced this convention for the responder and his rebid. The bid by the responder of the only unbid suit at his second turn is a waiting move and promises nothing about the suit itself.

Fourth Suit Forcing - Bridge Guys

Bidding: Checkback Stayman - A method similar to the New Minor Forcing convention for responder to determine if opener is holding a 4-card major or 3-cards in responders bid suit. See Details
Jargon: Chicago Convention - A illegal (tongue-in-cheek) convention used against one's opponents to claim a fouled hand. For instance, while playing Rubber Bridge one dishonest player picks up a hand ...

Glossary of Bridge Conventions : A-M - BridgeHands

Some partnerships refer to this method as PLOB, which is an acronym for Petty Little Odious Bid, of which a second version designated as Extended PLOB employs some similar developments with the stipulation that ...

New Minor Forcing - Bridge Guys

New Minor Forcing (NMF), is a contract bridge bidding convention used to find a 5-3 or 4-4 major suit fit after a specific sequence of bids in which opener has rebid one notrump. The convention is triggered by responder at his second turn by an artificial bid of two in an unbid minor; it requires that he hold five cards in the major he has previously bid and an unlimited hand ranging in value ...

When partner opened 1NT, if you have an unbalanced hand 8+ points, the best way to win more tricks is looking for 8 card major fit.

Bridge Conventions - Bridge World (Briç Alemi)

If your right-hand opponent bids over partner's double, then any "free" bid shows 6+ points and at least a 4-card suit. If the takeout double is redoubled, all bids are natural but jump suit bids become preemptive, showing at least 5 cards and 0-8 points.

By Kitty and Steve Cooper. Almost all hands of 22+ points are opened with an artificial bid of 2C; the exceptions are unbalanced hands with more than one suit that don't need to force to game or that would be too difficult to rebid.

Basic Bidding 11, Opening and Responding to Two Clubs ...

The Drury Convention is an artificial 2C response that's used by a passed hand after partner opens 1H or 1S in third or fourth seat. It shows 3+-card trump support and maximum playing values (10+ support points).

Whether you cover or not, your ♥ K will not win a trick because it's poorly placed with Declarer's ace ready to capture it. But if you cover the honor played from Dummy, you can hold Declarer to only two heart tricks. Covering the queen forces Declarer to play two of his honors (♥ Q and ♥ A) on the same trick, promoting Partner's ♥ T to a third round winner.
