In literature, art, or music, a recurring set of words, shapes, colors, or notes. In the poem "The Raven," by Edgar Allan Poe, for example, the word nevermore is a motif appearing at the end of each stanza. Likewise, the first four notes of the Fifth Symphony of Ludwig van Beethoven are a motif that is developed and reshaped throughout the work.

Definition of Motif. A motif is a narrative element with symbolic meaning that repeats throughout a work of literature. Motifs may come in the form of reoccurring imagery, language, structure, or contrasts. In drama, motifs may also take the form of repeated music, visual components, or physical movements. The development of motifs in a work of literature often contributes to mood and/or theme.

A leitmotif or leitmotiv / ˌl aɪ t m oʊ ˈ t iː f / is a "short, constantly recurring musical phrase" associated with a particular person, place, or idea. It is closely related to the musical concepts of *idée fixe* or motto-theme. The spelling leitmotif is an anglicization of the German Leitmotiv (IPA: [ˈlaɪtmotɪːf]), literally meaning "leading motif", or "guiding motif".

It developed from the Danse Macabre with an added erotic subtext.

ELPH is a general-purpose Gibbs sampler for finding motifs in a set of DNA or protein sequences. The program takes as input a set containing anywhere from a few dozen to thousands of sequences, and searches through them for the most common motif, assuming that each sequence contains one copy of the motif.
